Family-Based Immigration

- a) Spouse, minor and unmarried Children, and Parents of U.S. Citizens—NonPreference
- b) Unmarried sons/daughters over 21 of U.S. Citizens (FB-1)
- c) Spouse, minor and unmarried children of Lawful Permanent Resident (FB-2A) and Unmarried sons/daughters over 21 of LPR (FB-2B)
- d) Married sons/daughters of U.S. Citizens (FB-3)
- e) Brothers/sisters of U.S. Citizens where USC is over 21 (FB-4)

Employment-Based Immigration

- a) First Preference: Extraordinary Ability (EB-1)
- b) Second Preference: Exceptional Ability (EB-2)
- c) Third Preference: Skilled Workers (EB-3)
- d) Fourth Preference: Unskilled Workers, Shortage Occupations and Religious Workers (EB-4)
